The Grasberg-Ertzberg copper-gold district, West Papua, Indonesia. With a total resource of around 3Gt at 1% copper and 1g/t gold, this rich complex of porphyry and skarn orebodies has been regarded as the largest copper-gold deposit in the World with the largest gold reserve, and by-products molybdenum, palladium and platinum. Located at up to 4000m altitude on the crest of the Central Ranges, with 1500m vertical extent of mineralisation, the deposits have been mined since 1972, overcoming difficult access, engineering and weather. This talk covers exploration history, geology and mineralisation.
