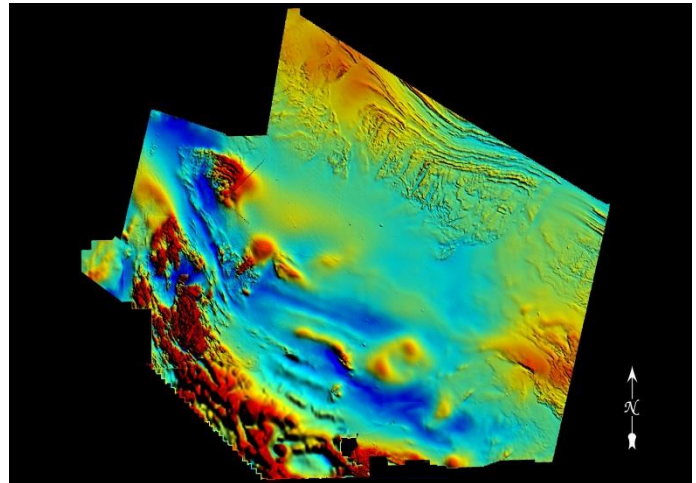

The Ministry of Business, Industry and Employment (MBIE) has been planning and funding Aeromagnetic Surveys over large areas of the North and South Islands since 2009. Areas covered to date include Northland, Westland, Nelson & Marlborough, Otago and Southland. MBIE's aim is to stimulate exploration interest in these areas, however the data is also very useful for civil engineering, geological mapping including tectonic and structural studies and soil mapping too.

The location of current and future planned data coverage will be illustrated; the aircraft and instrumentation utilised in the surveys discussed; and results to date that have been publicly released will be reviewed.

Paul Vidanovich is a consulting geophysicist. He has worked in exploration for over 30 years and in recent years among his other work commitments, has provided advice and QC services on all of MBIE's aeromagnetic surveys.
